With the support of the "grupo popular" the Teulada Moraira Town Hall has approved a motion for a bilateral agreement between Spain and the United Kingdom regarding Brexit

MOTION ON THE NEED FOR A BILATERAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SPAIN AND THE UNITED KINGDOM IN REFERENCE TO GREAT BRITAIN'S EXIT FROM THE EUROPEAN UNION ("BREXIT") STATEMENT OF CAUSAL FACTORS

On 23rd June 2016, British citizens participated in a referendum to decide on remaining part of the European Union. The voting, against all forecast and prediction, has chosen to situate the United Kingdom outside the European Union, together with 64 million British people. By a minimal margin, the British people said "Yes" to Brexit.

Convulsion and uncertainty then took control of the British and European economy and of the British citizenry, inside and outside of their country of birth. An uncertainty which has three main levels: political; economic; as citizens. The first of these, the political, affects the European construction and consolidation processes. The economic repercussion is evident, especially in our province with strong and leading tourist and business sectors, as they are on the Costa Blanca.

However, the citizen level, is the one with which this Council must be most concerned, since our British neighbours who have chosen the province of Alicante to live in and enjoy their lives, and more specifically, Teulada Moraira are many. They are people who have integrated into our society and play an important role in our community.

At the same time, we want to support the working and social rights of the Spanish citizens and those from Teulada Moraira who would like to spend time in the U.K. and enjoy opportunities there: furthering their education, in employment or undertaking their life project, since our two countries are joined by a close and warm relationship.

Moreover, Teulada Moraira is very grateful for the contribution which our resident British community makes, and which is especially notable in fundraising, voluntary and cultural activities. We understand that these activities constitute an excellent vehicle for integration and that they encourage a strong sense of social cohesion, friendship and solidarity.

Furthermore, these people have a deep commitment to Teulada Moraira and have formed strong, positive relationships and links with the town, via friendships, relationships, employment, associations, all of which involve a common element: working together. They are part of the fabric of our community. We have a commitment to them and to defending their rights, opportunities and obligations as equal members of our citizenry.

EU citizens have been able to elect and be elected in municipal elections in Spain since this right was recognized in the 1999 Maastricht Treaty. This has enabled them to vote in elections to choose their mayors and councillors, to stand as candidates for election and to represent voters at the local level, as has been the case and as it is currently.

For all of the aforementioned reasons, and given the social and economic importance of the more than 86,000 British people who live in our province, and more specifically, the more than 3,000 British people in our municipality, and the importance of our coexistence, the Partido Popular Municipal Group proposes to the plenary session of the Town Hall the adoption of the following

AGREEMENTS

1 To urge the Spanish Government to continue defending, as it has up to now, and actively informing all Spanish citizens resident in the United Kingdom until the type of exit from the Union and its date are made definitive, and also on how this will affect their status in the country.
